1. The Therapeutic Riding Center (25 youth) - youth will be cleaning tack and doing other odd cleaning jobs at the center, a place where people with disabilities learn to ride horses
 2. Days End Horse Rescue Farm (20 youth) 12:30 -3:30 - youth will be cleaning areas around the farm, a place that rehabilitates abused horses (will need a separate permission slip) http://www.defhr.org/pdf/vol_rel.pdf
 3. Making Bag Lunches for the homeless (15-20 youth at each church) at Columbia Chinese Baptist and at Bethel Korean Presbyterian - youth will make bag lunches at each church and then take them to Baltimore City to hand out to homeless people
 4. Giant Grocery Stores for food pantry collections (5 stores, 5 youth each, 25 youth) – Youth will sit outside of the grocery stores, handing customers paper lunch bags with preprinted lists of needed food items asking the customers to make a donation to local food pantries. If the youth are given money, they are then sent inside the store to purchase the items.
 5. Brighton Gardens (6 - 10 youth) 1:00 – 3:30 – youth will visit with the residents of this assisted living/Alzheimer’s facility
 6. Kennedy Krieger Institute (10 **high school students**) – youth will visit with the young patients at the institute, playing games or doing an arts project

7. Mt. Washington Pediatric Hospital (8 **high school students**) – youth will visit with the young patients at the hospital, playing games or doing an arts project
 8. Augsburg Lutheran Home in Lochearn (6youth) – youth will visit with the residents of the senior citizens facility.
 9. Recycling Center (20 – 30 youth) - youth will sort paper to prepare it for recycling
 10. Athelas houses (4 houses, 4-5 youth per house) youth will clean group homes of developmentally disabled adults
 11. Free lunch at Trinity Episcopal Church on Route 1 (5-6 youth) – youth will advertise and serve a free lunch of soup and bread to anyone who comes. Youth will advertise along Route 1 near the flea market and at the motel across the road that houses people of little to no income.
 12. Samaritan Women (15-20 Youth) – youth will plant seedlings in the green house and other work
 13. Assemble health kits for Lutheran World Relief to send to Haiti and other needy countries
